



# NOW WHAT?

### Next Steps

1. Depending on the specific program, submitted applications will either be reviewed on a rolling basis or after the deadline date (this will be stated on the brochure of each program).
2. If the program that you applied for requires an interview, you will be contacted directly by either the Douglas College Global Engagement Office, or a WCMN Coordinator from the host institution.
3. Once your application has been reviewed and the interview has been completed (if applicable), you will be contacted via email with the application decision.
4. There are 3 different application decision status:
  - a. Accepted – you have been accepted into the program.
  - b. Not accepted – you have not been accepted into the program.
  - c. Waitlisted – you have been accepted into the program, however, there are currently no spots available. When a spot opens up you will be considered for it.

Please note if you have been “accepted” into an exchange program, you will still need to be nominated to the host institution, and will be required to submit the host institution’s application. Final acceptance is provided by the host institution.

### What do if you have been accepted?

1. If you have been accepted, you will receive an Acceptance Letter via email.
2. The Acceptance Letter will include the following:
  - a. You will be asked to “commit or decline” your spot in the program.
  - b. Next steps such as pre-departure requirements, payment and registration instructions, flights, etc.
  - c. Any additional forms/requirements or need to know information.
3. Closer to your program start dates, you will meet with the other students (virtually or in-person) and will be provided with an outgoing orientation.

### What to do if you have not been accepted?

1. Do not feel discouraged! There will be plenty more opportunities to reapply!
2. You will be contacted via email if you did not get accepted into your desired program.

### What to do if you have been waitlisted?

1. You will be contacted via email if you have been placed on the waitlist.
2. If a spot opens up, your status will change to “accepted” and you will receive an Acceptance Letter via email with the next steps.
3. If you have not been offered a spot, your status will remain in “waitlisted”.
